Street Performer Permit

Q&A

What is the cost of the permit? *The cost for a permit is ten dollars (\$10) per year.*

How long is the permit valid? *The permit is valid for one year, from July 1st through June 30th, regardless of when the performer receives his or her permit. Permit fees will not be pro-rated.*

How do I/we renew a permit? *Fill out a new application each year by June 30th and turn into the Planning and Inspections Department at City Hall.*

Where can I/we perform? *A specific location must be determined. Performances shall be limited to the downtown area along Arendell Street from 4th to 11th Street, along Evans Street from 4th to 9th Street, and along Shepard Street from 7th to 9th Street. No performances shall be in front of residential areas, and you will be limited to performing at your permitted location ONLY. If you desire to perform at another location, an additional permit is required.*

Is my permit valid during special events (i.e., Seafood Festival, Big Rock Tournament, boat shows)? *No, if you wish to perform during a special event, you must get permission by contacting the event sponsor and following the vendor process.*

What hours may I/we operate? *Street performers are limited to the following hours in all public areas: 1) Monday through Thursday, 8am - 10pm; 2) Friday and Saturday, 8 am-12 midnight; and 3) Sunday, 12 noon-10 pm.*

Can I/we have public seating? *No seating, except for the performer, shall be provided by or at the direction of the performer without prior written consent of the City.*

Can we display signs? *No, with the exception of the permit, which is required to be posted during all performances.*
