CLOSED SESSION MINUTES

The Morehead City Council met in Closed Session following the regular Council Meeting to discuss settlement of an erosion control violation penalty, pending potential litigation and acquisition of property with the City Attorney. Those present were: Mayor Gerald A. Jones, Jr., Councilmen Floyd Chadwick, Paul Cordova, Robert Howard, John Nelson, Demus Thompson, City Manager R. Randy Martin, City Attorney Nelson Taylor and City Clerk Jeanne Giblin.

**Encroachment Dispute on 25<sup>th</sup> Street and Bay Street – Mr. William F. Britt and Mrs. Willis**

Manager Martin reported that the neighbor to Mr. Britt, a Mrs. Willis, has now put a fence along the same line matching Mr. Britt's fence encroaching on City property.

City Attorney Taylor suggested that a letter be written to Mr. Britt and Mrs. Willis that they will have to remove the fences from the property and if they do not do so the City will remove them. He continued that he is content that the City survey of the property is correct.

The Council concurred to send a letter to both Mrs. Willis and Mr. Britt requesting that the fences be removed.


**Police Chief Sammie Turner**
